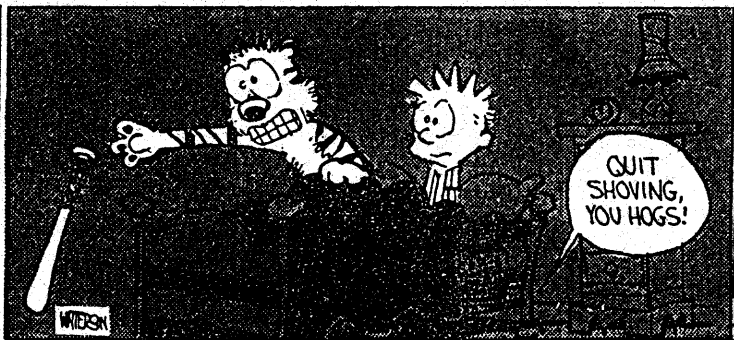
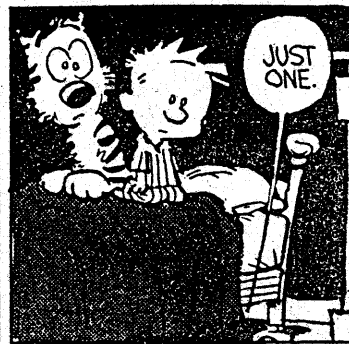
YOUR COUNTRY NEEDS YOU

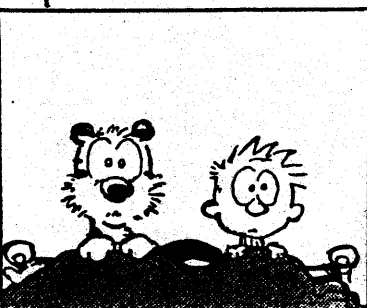
